JAR-145 ACCEPTANCES TRANSITIONING TO EASA PART 145 APPROVALS

Please be advised that the Agency is currently in the process of issuing EASA Part-145 certificates for some 600 organisations which are due for renewal in August of this year.

There may be some delay in issuing these certificates due to the volume of certificates that need to be delivered.

During this transition we would like to remind you that your JAR-145 acceptance is deemed to have been issued in accordance with EASA Part-145 and the Certificate will remain valid providing continued compliance with TGL 22 is satisfied. JAR-145 acceptances valid on 28 November 2003 remain valid until 28 November 2004 (reference Regulation 2042, Article 4).

Our intention is to issue all EASA Part-145 certificates to 'grandfathered' JAR 145 acceptances by 28 November 2004 in order to maintain continuity of the system.

We appreciate your support in this transition phase, and will do our utmost to issue your EASA Part 145 certificates as soon as possible.

Please continue to use the JAA TGL 22 for your applications at this time.
